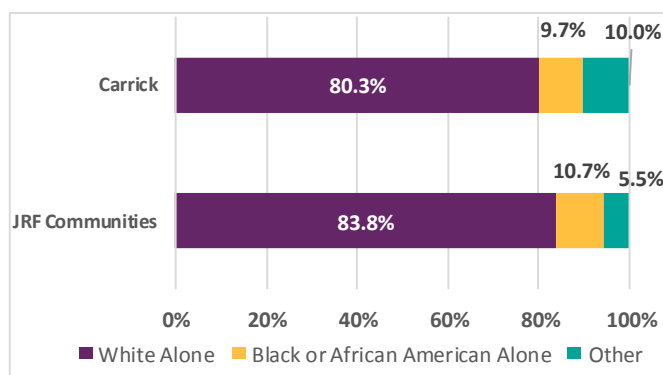

Population: 10,056

Population by Race/Ethnicity (2014)

- As of 2014, Carrick's total population was estimated at 10,056.
- The racial/ethnic composition of Carrick is similar to the Jefferson Regional Foundation Communities (JRF) though Carrick has a higher percentage of other races.
- 15% of the total population is over age 65 — lower than the JRF communities average (18%). Carrick residents between the ages of 18—64 makes up 65% of the population. Children under 18 account for 20% of the population.
- The median age for Carrick is 39. This is lower than JRF communities (43), and the city of Pittsburgh median age (33).

- In 2014, 1,823 residents of Carrick (18% of the total population) received SNAP benefits.

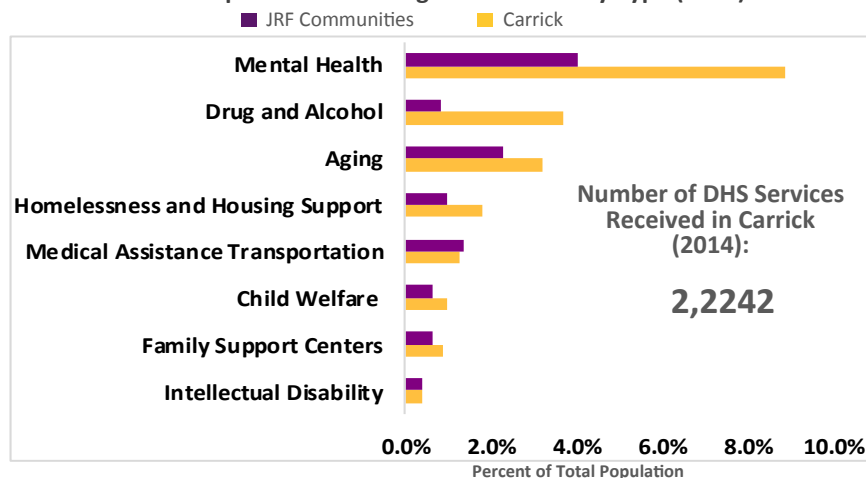
Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) provides human services to Allegheny County residents, including emergency help and support for long term needs. Below is break down of services provided by DHS by percent of total population. Carrick is compared with the JRF Communities. Mental Health Services and Drug and Alcohol Services were the most utilized for Carrick—with almost 9% of the total population utilizing Mental Health Services.
