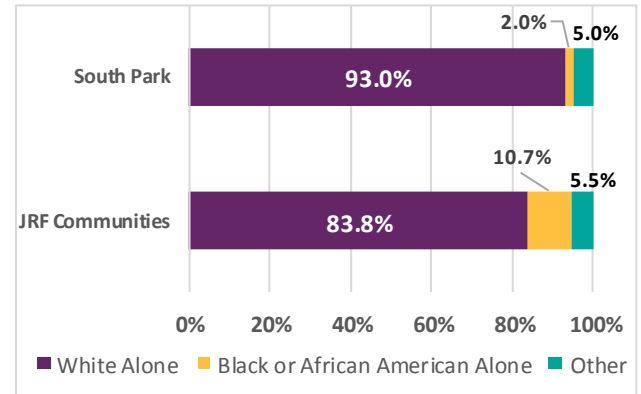

Population: 13,492

Population by Race/Ethnicity (2014):

- As of 2014, South Park total population was estimated at 13,492. This is a 6% decline from a total of 14,340 reported in 2000¹.
- The population is majority white (93%), a higher percentage than the Jefferson Regional Foundation (JRF) Communities average.
- 22% of the total population is over age 65 — higher than JRF Communities (19%) and the City of Pittsburgh (14%). South Park residents ages 18–64 make up 63% of the population. Children under the age of 18 account for 21% of the population.
- The median age for South Park increased from 38 to 43. This is similar to the JRF communities (43), while the city of Pittsburgh median age is 33 and has decreased since 2000¹.

- In 2014, 510 South Park residents (3.8% of the total population) received SNAP benefits.

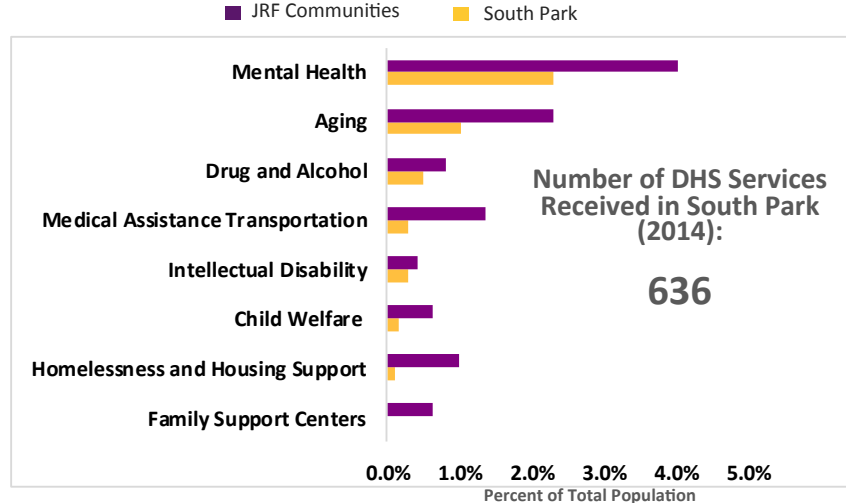
Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) provides human services to Allegheny County residents, including emergency help and support for long term needs. Below is break down of services provided by DHS by percent of total population. South Park is compared with the JRF Communities. Aging and Mental Health Services were the most utilized for South Park and the combined JRF Communities. The JRF communities had a higher percentage of use for all types of service.
