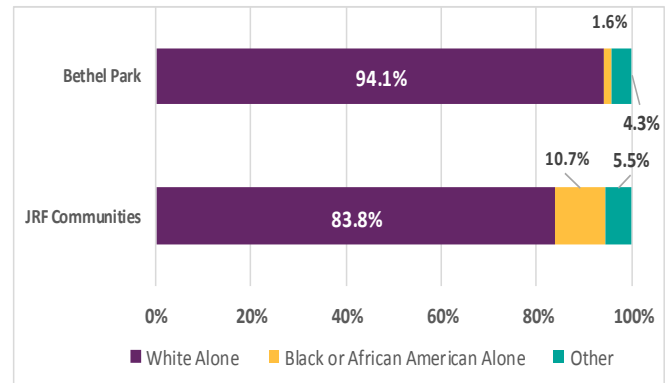

Population: 32,338

- The 2014 Bethel Park total population was estimated at 32,338—a decline of 3.6% from 32,338 reported in 2000¹.
- The racial/ethnic composition is 94.1% white, 1.6% African American and 4.3% other races.
- 20% of the total population is over age 65 — higher than both Allegheny County (17%) and the City of Pittsburgh (14%). Bethel Park residents between the ages of 18—64 make up 60% of the population. Children under 18 account for 20% of the population.
- The median age for Bethel Park is 46. This is higher than other JRF communities (43), and higher than the city of Pittsburgh (33).

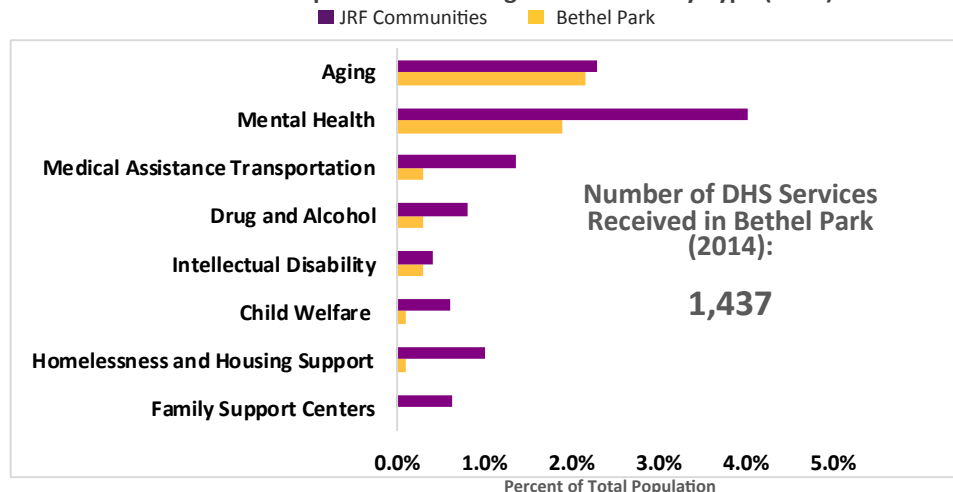

- In 2014, 654 Bethel Park residents (2% of the total population) received SNAP benefits.

Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) provides human services to Allegheny County residents, including emergency help and support for long term needs. Below is break down of services provided by DHS by percent of total population. Bethel Park is compared with the JRF Communities. Aging and Mental Health Services were the most utilized for both. The percent of Bethel Park residents using DHS services was less than the JRF Community average for all types of services.
