

Population: 11,355

Population by Race/Ethnicity (2014):

- As of 2014, the Munhall total population was estimated at 11,355 which is a decline from 12,264 in 2000.¹
- The racial/ethnic composition of Munhall is similar to JRF Communities and Allegheny County as a whole.
- 14% of the total population is over age 65 lower than Allegheny County (17%) and the same as the City of Pittsburgh (14%). Munhall residents between the ages of 18 and 64 make up 63% of the population. Children under the age 18 account for 18% of the population.
- The median age for Munhall is 44. This median is similar to other JRF communities (43), while the city of Pittsburgh median age is 33 and has decreased since 2000.¹



Public Transportation

JRF Communities: 8.5%

- 6.5% of population age 16 and over take public transportation to work.
- 18% of Munhall households do not have access to a vehicle.

Median Household Income

JRF Communities: \$49,773

- On average, 6% of Munhall families have income below the poverty level.
- 33% of those families are single mother families.

College Education

JRF Communities: 26%

- 22% of population 25 years old and over has completed a Bachelor's Degree or higher.
- High School Graduate is the highest level of education for the majority of residents (43%).

Labor Force

JRF Communities: 63%

- 65% of population age 16 and over is in the labor force.
- The labor force for Munhall is 48% female, 52% male.

Owner-Occupied Housing

- Of the 5,288
 occupied housing
 units in Munhall,
 66% are owner occupied and 34.3% are
 renter occupied.
- 12.3% of housing units are vacant.


JRF Communities: 62

- In 2015, 4 residents of the zip code 15120 fatally accidentally overdosed.
- This is a decrease from 8 deaths in 2008.
