

25 Ways to Promote an Accurate 2020 Census Count

Electronic Promotion:

- 1. Place information on your organization's website
- 2. Share information via social media (Facebook and Twitter announcements)
- 3. Electronic newsletters
- 4. Digital signs at your organization's site
- 5. Add National Census Day (April 1st) to your organization's calendar
- 6. Share information in monthly email blasts
- 7. Include a message about the Census in an email signature
- 8. Recruit local residents to serve as trusted Census workers from the community by sharing this Census Bureau application link on your online platforms: <u>https://2020census.gov/en/jobs.html</u>
- 9. Utilize volunteers or robocall system to make reminder calls about participating in the Census

Print Promotion:

- 10. Print information in newsletter
- 11. Include flyers in mailings
- 12. Display Jefferson Counts Census posters and handouts at your organization's site
- 13. Display Census Bureau recruitment posters: <u>https://jeffersonrf.org/2020census/</u>
- 14. Incorporate printed Census materials into meetings with your clients

In-Person Promotion/Presentations:

- 15. Place the Census as an agenda item at staff or board meetings
- 16. Ask community members to fill out a pledge card, committing to participating in the Census
- 17. Educate community members and staff on the importance of participating in the Census
- 18. Train your staff on how to educate community members about the Census
- 19. Pass information to state representatives

Event Promotion:

- 20. Share the importance of the Census at your organization's existing events or services
- 21. Host a Census training for your community with Jefferson Regional Foundation's assistance
- 22. Ask local elected representatives to hold an event or informative session (especially for seniors)
- 23. Promote at 5k events, President's Day, Memorial Day parade, or local events
- 24. Work with local libraries to hold online enrollment sessions and trainings to help seniors and community members complete their Census
- 25. Become a Census HUB and assist residents with completing their Census form

Key Census Messages to Share:

- The Census brings resources and funds into our community
- Emphasize early participation to avoid the Census Bureau visiting your home
- Every person in our community counts
