
People

Population: 11,442

- The South Allegheny School District (SASD) total population decreased by 4% from 11,904 in 2010.¹
- The SASD population represents about 5% of the total Jefferson area population and comprises the Glassport, Liberty, Lincoln, and Port Vue municipalities.
- Similar to the Jefferson region as a whole, the school district is experiencing changing racial demographics.
 SASD is becoming more diverse. The white population decreased by 1,632 (14%) while all other races saw growth.¹
- The Black and Multi-Racial populations in the SASD Communities grew by 250% and 337%, respectively, between 2010 and 2020, reflecting trends in the Jefferson area.¹
- 19% of the total population is over age 65— similar to Allegheny County (19%) and higher than the City of Pittsburgh (15%). Ages 18—64 make up 63% of the SASD Communities and under 18 accounts for 18%. Median age in the SASD is 45, higher than Allegheny County (41) and the City of Pittsburgh (33).

- 5% of population age 16 and over take public transportation to work.
- 82% of workers drive alone with avg. commute time of 30 min.

Median Household Income

All JRF: \$57,879 Allegheny County: \$62,320 City of Pittsburgh: \$50,536

- On average, 19% of SASD Community families have income below 200% of the federal poverty level (FPL).
- 49% of families under 100% of the FPL are single mother families.

College Education

All JRF: 30% Allegheny County: 43% City of Pittsburgh: 45%

- 17% of population 25 years old and over has completed a Bachelor's Degree or higher.
- This represents a slight increase from 2015 estimates (14%).

Labor Force

All JRF: 64% Allegheny County: 65% City of Pittsburgh: 64%

- 69% of residents age 16 and over are in the labor force.
- The labor force for the SASD is 48% female, 52% male.

Owner-Occupied Housing

75%

All JRF: 71% Allegheny County: 65% City of Pittsburgh: 49%

- 75% of occupied housing units are owner occupied and 25% are renter occupied.
- 87% of housing units are occupied.

Community

PA 211 Data shows that requests for housing & shelter assistance peaked in October 2020 (28 requests), May 2021 (38), and August 2021 (28) with roughly 21% of requests submitted during those months alone.


From March-April 2021, residents submitted 96 requests related to Healthcare & COVID-19 assistance, accounting for 39% of such requests. 20% (50) requests related to COVID-19 vaccination.
